The "Removal and Nail Nutrition" Kit:

STUCK WITH GEL POLISH BUT CAN'T MAKE IT TO THE SALON FOR REMOVAL? PEACCI HAS YOU COVERED WITH EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO REMOVE YOUR GEL MANICURE AT HOME.

120/180 Nail file: Use this to file-off the top coat from your manicure, before you begin the soak-off process.

Removal wipes: soak these in acetone and then pop them inside your removal clips. For easy removal with the fluff of cotton-wool!

Peacci Soak Away - A soak-off liquid that will remove gel polish or acrylic products whilst being kind to your natural nail plate. Soak your wipes in this and pop them inside your removal clips, or pour it into a bowl and dip your fingers straight in! See bottle instructions for further information. Gel polish should be soaked off for at least 10 minutes in Soak Away liquid.

Removal clips: These handy removal clips abolish the need for tin foil, just pop a wipe saturated in acetone inside the top of one of these clips and close it around your finger, ensuring the wipe is firmly pressed onto your nail. The best part? They are touch-screen enabled, so you can keep scrolling on Insta, even whilst you soak!

Pusher tool: Use this to (gently) scrape the gel away once it has been left to soak for at least 10 minutes.

Nail buffer: Use the rough side to lightly buff any remaining gel and then, once there are no traces of gel left, swap to the smoother side to buff your nail until it's smooth and soft.

220/240 Nail file: Use this to gently file the nail, moving in one direction, to get your fresh nail into the perfect shape.

Peacci cuticle remover: Paint over your cuticles and then push back using the tool. To remove dry skin and hang nails.

Peacci cuticle oil: After finishing a soak-off it's important to rehydrate. Massage our Peach scented oil into your cuticles to give your tips the nourishment and nutrition they crave. An essential to keep hands hydrated that are dried out from repeated use of hand-sanitizer and artificial nail products!

Peacci 2in1 Base Coat: a strengthening, pruning base coat to add a layer of strength and support to your fresh nail plate
